<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Standard school stationery Exercise book, vocabulary book and text book (provided by school) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Ask them to teach you what they've learnt once a week Encourage them to speak in French as much as possible Help them learn their vocabulary and grammar regularly – even if you don't speak the language you can still do this!

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Students will self-mark and peer-mark some exercises Fortnightly vocabulary tests Key homework tasks will be graded using the NGHS Marking Policy Half-termly assessments in two skills End of year examination 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Look out for opportunities to practise speaking/listening to the language – eg French films, additional vocabulary, YouTube channels, etc Consider a visit to a French-speaking country where you can practise!
