Practical Subjects - Art, Music, Drama, DT, Computer Science & PSHE Students may occasionally be set a small amount of homework, often related to specific project work to be completed over a period of time. Students may occasionally be asked to conduct brief research relating to a particular topic or to bring something in for the next lesson.

Year 9-11

At GCSE, students will be set homework at the discretion of the subject teacher, to maximise the effectiveness of this whilst allowing for flexibility.

However, the general rule is that students will be set homework once per subject per week, and each homework set should take around 30-60 minutes. In Maths and English, students may be set homework on two occasions.

In addition to this, the number of days given to complete the homework will be proportional to the nature and demands of the task, to allow sufficient and appropriate time. This will generally be around 3-5 days.
