Equipment needed for lessons Standard school stationery • Ask them to teach you what they've learnt once a week Exercise book, vocabulary book and text book (provided by school) Encourage them to speak in French as much as possible Help them learn their vocabulary and grammar regularly – even if you don't speak the language you can still do this! Extension & Enrichment opportunities How will learning be assessed and progress measured? Students will self-mark and peer-mark some exercises Look out for opportunities to practise speaking/listening to the language - eg French films, additional vocabulary, YouTube channels, etc Fortnightly vocabulary tests • Consider a visit to a French-speaking country where you can practise! Key homework tasks will be graded using the NGHS Marking Policy Half-termly assessments in two skills
