End of Term

We finish next Thursday at 12.30pm. Haberdashers Adams have now decided to remain in school until 3.45pm and therefore the Adams buses will not run before then. The T&W Assisted Buses will be outside school at 12.30pm. We have considered extending our day until 3.45pm for all, however, there is an aspect of the building work which needs to be completed on the Thursday afternoon prior to the Easter break and I had already given clearance for this. It will affect part of the original building so we are unable to have all students in school. We are sure most students will be able to leave at 12.30pm. If, however you are unable to make arrangements for 12.30pm, please advise us via our Reception email (schooloffice@nghs.org.uk) no later than Tuesday at 3pm and we will make student arrangements to remain in school under staff supervision for the afternoon. Students will be kept in bubbles and will be informed where to meet on Thursday. Food can be bought at breaktime or bring a packed lunch. We return on Monday 19 April at 8.50am.

Internal Exams - w/c 10 May 2021

w/c 10 May is the calendared formal school exam week. We have given consideration to the impact of the recent Covid lockdown (although colleagues do not feel that any year group is 'behind' where they should be despite what you might read in the media). Whilst assessment throughout the course is important, we have varied our approach concerning internal exam week. Students in Year 10 and Year 12 will sit examination papers during the week in school as normal. Some will be in a formal exam hall setting and others in classrooms. Students in Years 7-9 will not have a formal exam week, however, they will complete an in-class assessment between 10th-28th May during lesson time lasting around 45 minutes.

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Home Testing Kits

The DFH and DFE want Home Testing to continue over Easter. Thank you to all parents who have been logging results. Students will be provided with further test kits next week and Mrs Davenport is coordinating this. INSET Day/Curriculum Enrichment Week

We intend to hold our Curriculum Enrichment Week from 28 June to 2 July. For parents of lower school students who may not know about the week; this is an enjoyable week where lessons are suspended and year group activities are planned. Year 10 will be on Work Experience (in person or virtual; Mrs Gill is coordinating) and Years 7-9 and Y12 will be in school. We may be able to arrange day trips to local places of interest; to be confirmed based upon national restrictions, which should have eased by then. Students will be engaged in activities based around different subject areas. Year 12 will be focused on university/ apprenticeship applications and the launch of our Extended Project qualification. We normally take Year 12 to University of Birmingham - to be confirmed. The Monday (28 June) has however been set as an INSET day which was postponed earlier in the year. This will not affect Year 10 nor Year 11/13 who will have 'left' by then, but Years 7-9 and 12 should not expect to be in school on 28th and CEW will run Tuesday to Friday.
