## STATEMENT CONCERNING SEPTEMBER 2020 ENTRANCE TEST

During the Covid-19 pandemic, the Grammar Schools Consortium for Shropshire, Walsall and Wolverhampton wish to reassure parents, carers and primary school pupils that we are continuing to plan for the Entrance Test to take place on/around Monday 14 September 2020.
